reference and celebrate femininity. In a nod to unity and camaraderie among women worldwide, each of the collection's color names include the pronouns "us", "we" or "her" such as Heather, Blush, and Seaweed among many others.

Muse Patterns:

Elena: The star of the collection, Elena is a matelassé inspired by movement and dance, and featuring figures representing interconnectedness and uplifting others, in four colorways.

Frida: Horizontal brushstrokes of black and white twisted yarns in Frida embody motion, reading as a dimensional texture from a distance, in nine colorways.

Ora: The twisting helix motif in Ora conjures references to DNA, the flow of water and energy, and graceful movement, in seven colorways.

Muse by V Starr for Wolf-Gordon will debut in December 2021, and will be previewed at NeoCon at the MART on October 4th-6th in Wolf-Gordon's showroom #10-161.
